

Mandate for the Advisory Board for MRR at NHH

Purpose

The advisory body shall contribute to ensuring that the Norwegian School of Economics (NHH) achieves its goal of offering an attractive Master's Programme in Accounting and Auditing (MRR) of high academic quality, providing relevant competencies for the education of certified public accountants. This particularly applies to, but is not limited to, providing support and advice on

- (1) the design and academic content of the MRR programme.
- (2) recruiting qualified students for the MRR programme in Bergen and Oslo.
- (3) the use of professional resources from auditing firms and the Norwegian Institute of Public Accountants (DnR) in the MRR programme.
- (4) access to personnel and data from auditing firms and DnR for research purposes.

Composition

The advisory body consists of one member from the leadership of each auditing firm (BDO, Deloitte, EY, KPMG, and PwC) and one member from DnR. Members are appointed by NHH for a term of four years.

NHH is represented in the advisory body by the Head of the Department of Accounting, Auditing, and Law (IRRR) and the Academic Director for MRR. Other members of NHH's leadership and academic staff responsible for MRR participate in the advisory body as needed.

The Academic Director for MRR serves as the Chair of the advisory body.

Decision-Making Authority

The advisory body provides advice to the leadership of MRR and NHH, as well as to NHH's decision-making bodies.

Meeting Activity

The advisory body normally meets twice a year, but more frequent meetings may be arranged as needed.
