



Internship abroad and Rikkyo University

Exchange to Rikkyo University must take place in combination with an internship via the Internship Abroad Course. NHH has entered into an agreement with the Norwegian Chamber of Commerce in Japan for them to provide internships for NHH students in their corporate members in combination with exchange to Rikkyo University. Master students can participate in the fall semester. Please note that the internship is unpaid.

Students participating in the program will complete internships lasting a minimum of four weeks, full time, before the start of the exchange semester at Rikkyo University. The fall semester starts in the middle of September. Only students who are citizens of countries exempted from obtaining a visa to enter Japan can participate.

Please note that this offer is a part of the internship abroad programme and the course requires that you attend a mandatory pre-departure workshop. Read more about this on <u>our website</u>.

How to apply

To participate, students apply for exchange by the regular exchange deadline and include a motivation letter directed to the internship in addition to a regular motivation letter directed towards exchange. Which corporate member a student will get an internship in depends on the student's experience and interests and which corporate members want an intern that semester.

If you receive an offer and accept it, we will forward your CV and motivation letter to the Norwegian Chamber of Commerce in Japan and they will contact you.
