

- Gives the title MSc in Economics and Business Administration
 ✓ Master i Økonomi og Administrasjon in Norwegian
- Final part of the 5-year siviløkonom programme for those admitted based on Bachelor i Økonomi og Administrasjon (BØA)
 ✓ or similar programmes fulfilling specific requirements

Programme structure

- ✓ Six courses (45 ECTS)
- ✓ At least three of these courses outside of your major
- \checkmark Some of the electives can be combined as a minor on the diploma

• Excellent international opportunities

- ✓ Various international opportunities count as electives
- ✓ Approximately half of the students spend at least half a year abroad

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Programme requirements

- Mandatory core courses
 - ✓ Specific requirements for each major
 - ✓ Form the basis for many more specialised courses
- At least one course (7.5 ECTS) in empirical methods
 - Ensures good methodological skills
 - ✓ Useful for your thesis work
 - ✓ Course must be chosen within your major
 - ✓ See description of individual majors for available courses
- Ethics course requirement
 - ✓ At least 2.5 ECTS, but most of the ethics courses are 7.5 ECTS
 - \checkmark Can be taken as part of the major or as one of the electives
 - ✓ Gives very valuable insights into ethics, responsibility and sustainability
