- Is the final part of the 5-year "siviløkonom" programme

## Programme structure

To ensure deep and broad knowledge and skills

$\checkmark$ Six courses（45 ECTS）from one of the majors
$\checkmark$ A master thesis（30 ECTS）on a topic within your major．
－Electives
$\checkmark$ Six courses（45 ECTS）
$\checkmark$ At least three of these courses outside of your major
$\checkmark$ Some of the electives can be combined as a minor（støtteprofil）on the diploma．
－Excellent international opportunities
$\checkmark$ Various international opportunities count as electives
$\checkmark$ Approximately half of the students spend at least half a year abroad．

## Programme requirements

- Mandatory core courses

- At least one course (7.5 ECTS) in empirical methods
$\checkmark$ Ensures good methodological skills
$\checkmark$ Gives a solid basis for your master thesis work
$\checkmark$ Must be chosen within your major
$\checkmark$ See description of individual majors for available courses.
- Ethics course requirement
$\checkmark$ At least 2.5 ECTS, but most of the ethics courses are 7.5 ECTS
$\checkmark$ Can be taken as part of the major or as one of the electives
$\checkmark$ Gives a solid foundation in ethics, responsibility and sustainability
