



## MANDATE - PEDAGOGICAL ACADEMY

The Pedagogical Academy at the Norwegian School of Economics consists of faculty members awarded the status of Excellent Teaching Practitioner and is part of the learning infrastructure at NHH.

The Pedagogical Academy will contribute to a good learning environment and a collegial teaching culture by participating in the pedagogical development work.

Examples of tasks are:

- to share experiences with and guide colleagues (mentoring)
- to participate in assessment committees
- to contribute to the development and dissemination of 'best practice' in teaching and learning
- to provide inspiration and support for further development of the pedagogical offerings
- to organise and hold seminars or other collegial forums for teaching development

Vice Rector for Academic Affairs appoints the leader and deputy leader of the Pedagogical Academy for a period of up to two years, after input from the academy's members.

The leader of the Pedagogical Academy is responsible for calling and conducting meetings at least twice per semester.

Vice Rector for Academic Affairs has the right to speak and attend meetings in the Pedagogical Academy. If the Vice Rector for Academic Affairs is also a merited teacher, he or she becomes a member of the academy, on an equal footing with the other members.
