Every year all master candidates are invited to participate in NHH's Job Market Survey half a year after their graduation. The survey examines their transition to the labour market, and how they assess their own education. The results from the survey are put to use in NHH's continuous work to maintain and improve our position as a high-quality institution and our relevance for students, the labour market and society as a whole.

About the survey

The survey was carried out between 15 December 2016 and 15 January 2017. 310 out of 497 candidates (62,4%) of the MSc in Economics and Business Administration participated. The respondents are representative to the population of the MSc-candidates, both in terms of gender, age, nationality and the distribution of majors within the master programme.

MAIN OCCUPATION SIX MONTHS AFTER GRADUATION






DID YOU GET A JOB BEFORE GRADUATING FROM NHH?




GROSS ANNUAL INCOME (AVERAGE) (NOK)



ANNUAL BENEFITS (AVERAGE) (NOK)




TOTAL ANNUAL SALARY (AVERAGE) (NOK)



EMPLOYMENT BY SECTOR




ENTREPRENEURSHIP AMONG NHH-CANDIDATES



Share of candidates working full time in their own company/business


EMPLOYMENT BY LINE OF BUSINESS


