The Pedagogical Academy at NHH consists of NHH's recognised teaching staff and is part of the institution's learning infrastructure.

The Pedagogical Academy aims to contribute to a positive learning environment and a collegial teaching culture by participating in pedagogical development activities.

Examples of tasks include

- sharing experiences with and mentoring colleagues
- participating in evaluation committees
- contributing to the development and dissemination of 'best practices' in teaching and learning
- providing inspiration and support for the further development of pedagogical offerings.
- organising and hosting seminars or similar events for teaching development.

The Vice Rector for Academic Affairs appoints the Chair and Deputy Chair of the Pedagogical Academy for a term of up to two years, based on input from the academy's members.

The Chair of the Pedagogical Academy is responsible for calling and conducting meetings at least twice per semester.

The Vice Rector for Academic Affairs has the right to attend and speak at meetings of the Pedagogical Academy. If the Vice Rector for Academic Affairs is also a recognised teacher, they will join the academy as a member on equal terms with other members.

The Section for Educational Quality provides administrative support to the Pedagogical Academy.
