The Cristin system

- NPI / NVI / NSD / NPU / UHR
- Publication points
- Level 1 and Level 2 publications
- The academic publication

Publication points

- Approved publications are awarded points each year
- Points are converted into funding
- NOT supposed to be used for benchmarking
- Authorship share

$$\sqrt{\frac{n}{N}} * (f \wedge k) * i = ?$$



Publication base points

Type	Level 1	Level 2
Monograph	5 points	8 points
Anthology Chapter	0,7 points	1 point
Journal Article	1 point	3 points

Level 2 journal = 3 base points

0,5 author share to NHH

SQRT of 0,5 = 0,707

Hugh Gravelle ^a, Fred Schroyen ^b

International co-author = 30% extra weight

Total points = 2,75 points to NHH

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Academic Publications

- **4 criteria** – all must be satisfied
 - present **new insight** (academic reviews are counted)
 - be presented in a form that allows the finding to be **verified** and/or used in new research
 - be written in a language and have a distribution that make it **accessible** to the majority of interested researchers
 - appear in an authorized publication channel (journal, series, book publishers, website) that has procedures for external **peer review**



Level 1 & Level 2

- Must be pre-approved
- Arranged by academic field
- Level 1 – everything that can be included from the definition
 - Updated continuously through an up-to-date register (NSD)
 - Peer review most important
 - Not more than 2/3 of authors from single institution
- Leading 20% within academic field
 - Elected by National Board of Scholarly Publishing (UHR) each year
- Level 1: 1622 publishers / 25696 Journals
- Level 2: 85 publishers / 2121 Journals



Points = funding

- NOK awarded for points differ each year
- Fixed amount of funds
- 35.000 NOK per point???
- 7 Million NOK ???

3. Select language
4. Fill in the title
5. Search the publisher or journal
6. Select type of publication
7. Enter the year and publication status
8. Add authors
