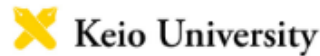

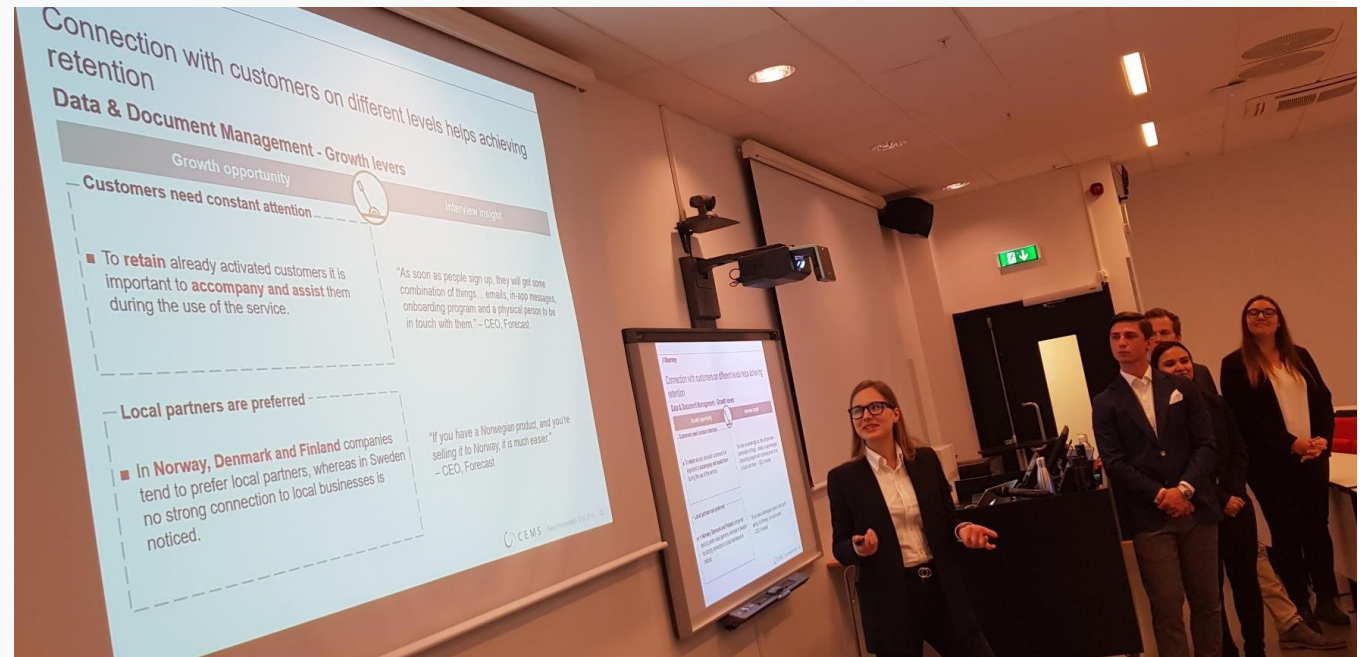

CEMS Internship opportunities

CEMS MIM includes a mandatory 8-week international internship:

- ✓ Gives you international experience and an opportunity to apply your skills and competences
- ✓ Should be in a country other than your home institution (*with possible exceptions for international students*)
- ✓ To be completed before graduation from CEMS


CEMS 2019 Graduate Profile:

- ✓ 96% are employed or continuing their studies
- ✓ 92% have worked outside of their home country
- ✓ 75% work for multinational companies

CEMS Alumni Profile:

- ✓ 97% are employed or continuing their studies
- ✓ 48% are currently working outside of their home country
- ✓ 82% have worked abroad and on average for 5 years outside their home country in 2-3 different countries
- ✓ 47% have worked for a CEMS Corporate Partner

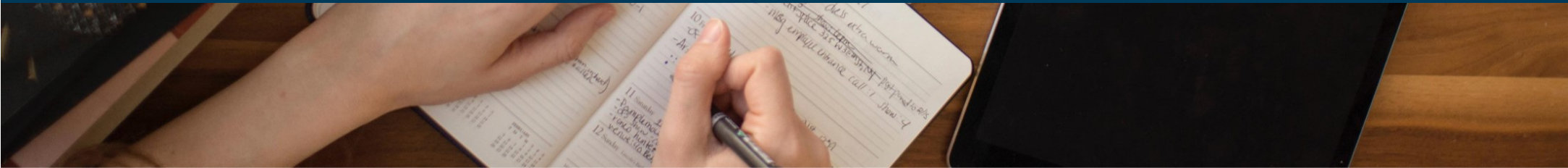

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The CEMS application process



Selection criteria



- ✓ Grades
- ✓ Language qualifications
- ✓ Motivation for international career
- ✓ Personal skills and willingness to take responsibility in society
- ✓ Curriculum Vitae
- ✓ Assessment Centre (in January each year)

Language qualifications

- **Language 1:** English
 - ✓ *Mother tongue or proficiency*
- **Language 2:** Any language
 - ✓ *Mother tongue or B2 Oral/B1 written level*
- **Language 3:** Any language
 - ✓ *Mother tongue or elementary*

Entry exam: English

- ✓ *TOEFL (iBT100) or IELTS (7.0)*

Exit requirement: Other languages
