Language Requirement for International Master's in Finance at Nova School of Business and Economics

English level

Students applying to the International Master's in Finance must have an English level of at least C1.

Second language level

Student's second language (or mother tongue*) must be at a minimum of B1.

Third language level**

Student's third language must be at a minimum of B1.

*If you have two mother tongues, you must request the "Honour Statement for Billingual Candidates" form.

**You can be admitted with an A2-level for the second/third language, but by the end of the programme, you must provide the B1 certificate. If you don't comply with this graduation requirement, you must enrol for an additional paid semester at Nova and complete the language certification. The price for this additional semester is €2200.

Please note that High School diplomas are not accepted as evidence of language proficiency.

Please not that your third language cannot be Swedish or Danish if your mother tongue is Norwegian.
