You will study in our **Mannheim Master in Management** program. Our Business School is one of the most renowned in Europe, known as the breeding ground for future managers.
Six areas of study cover a broad spectrum of research and teaching fields in business administration.



DEGREES

Upon successful completion, you will be awarded with the 'Master in Management M.Sc.' by the University of Mannheim and the 'M.Sc. in Economics and Business Administration' by the Norwegian School of Economics (NHH).

STUDY PLAN

In general, double degree students take all course work required to obtain both degrees without extending the standard study period of four semesters. Therefore, please make sure to plan your course of studies thoroughly as early as possible (according to the plan below).

You will spend the first part of your studies at NHH. During this time you should take a major (6 courses) and two electives. When selecting your courses, please already decide at which chair in Mannheim you wish to write your master thesis: Optimally, you will fulfill the courses required for a research seminar before coming to Mannheim by taking the respective equivalents at NHH.

During the second part of your studies, you will be studying at the University of Mannheim where you will take the core courses of the MMM as well as electives worth at least 2 ECTS and a research seminar (7xx module). Please keep in mind that you have to fulfill certain academic requirements for writing a master thesis. Details can be found in section 5 of the MMM module catalog.
