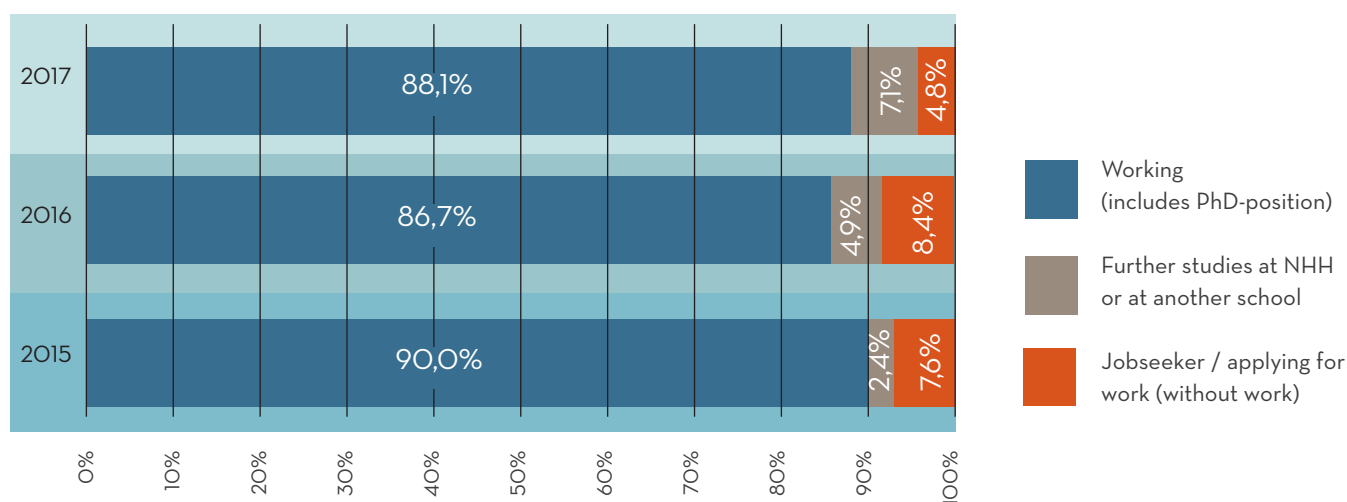
# JOB MARKET SURVEY 2017

Every year all master candidates are invited to participate in NHH's Job Market Survey half a year after their graduation. The survey examines their transition to the labour market, and how they assess their own education. The results from the survey are put to use in NHH's continuous work to maintain and improve our position as a high-quality institution and our relevance for students, the labour market and society as a whole.

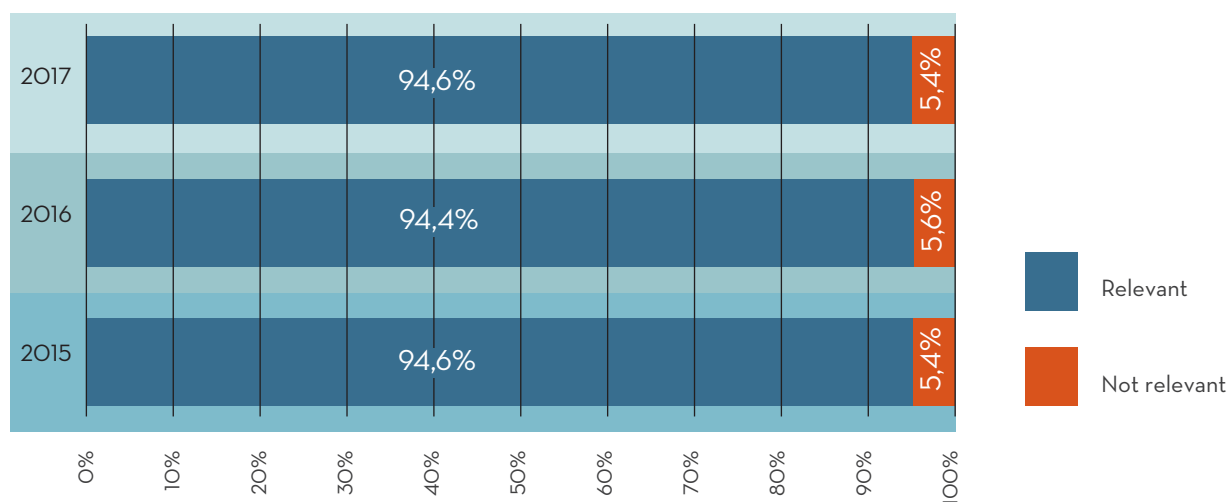
## About the survey

The survey was carried out between 23 February and 5 March 2018. 168 out of 498 candidates (34 %) at the MSc in Economics and Business Administration participated. The respondents are representative to the population of the MSc-candidates, both in terms of gender, age and to a large extent in the distribution of majors within the master's programme. Due to a technical error in the English version of the survey, respondents answering in English have been excluded. This includes all international degree students.

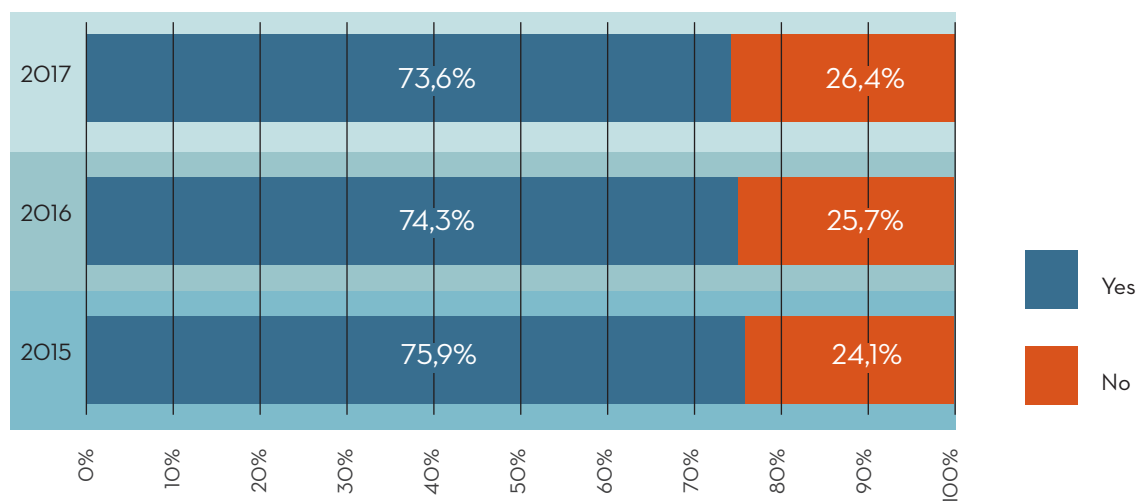
## MAIN OCCUPATION SIX MONTHS AFTER GRADUATION



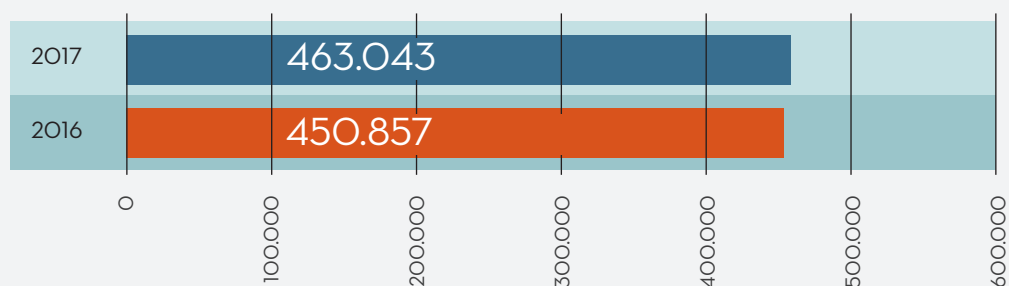
## DO YOU CONSIDER THE JOB TO BE RELEVANT TO THE NHH-EDUCATION?



## DID YOU GET A JOB BEFORE GRADUATING FROM NHH?

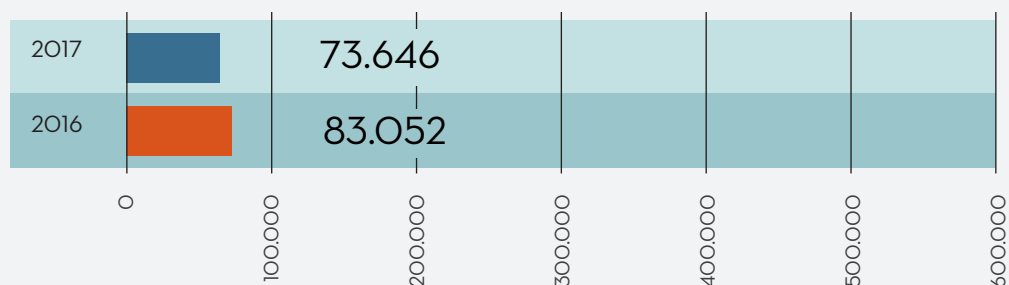


## GROSS ANNUAL INCOME (AVERAGE) (NOK)



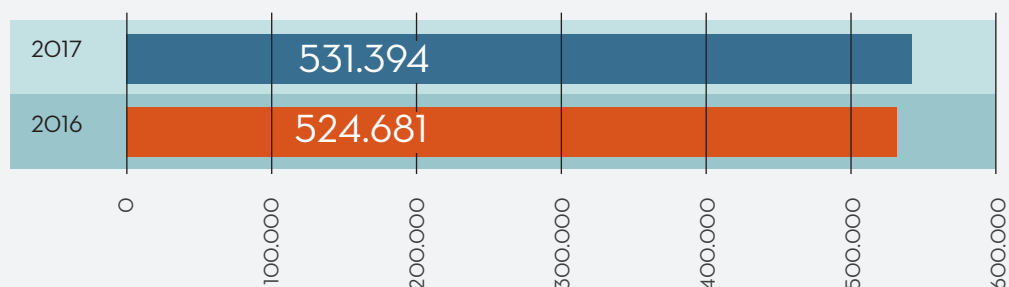

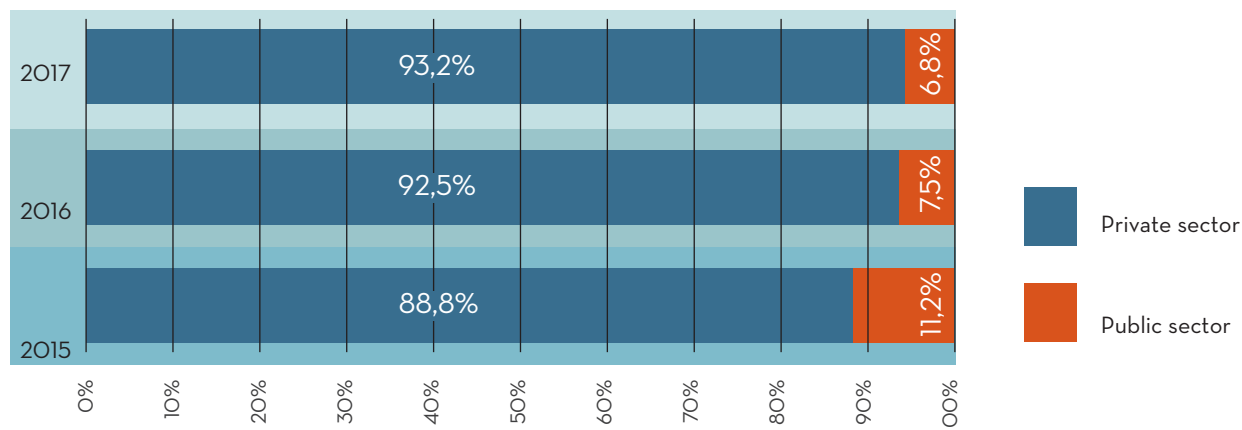
## TOTAL ANNUAL SALARY (AVERAGE) (NOK)



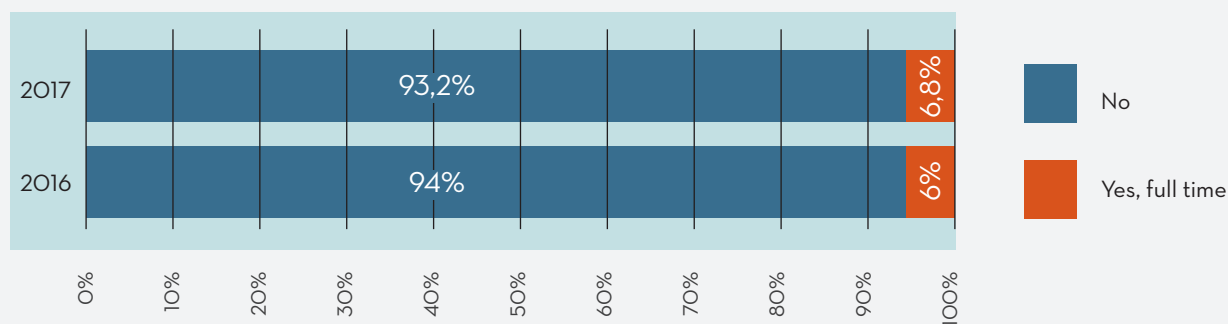

## EMPLOYMENT BY SECTOR

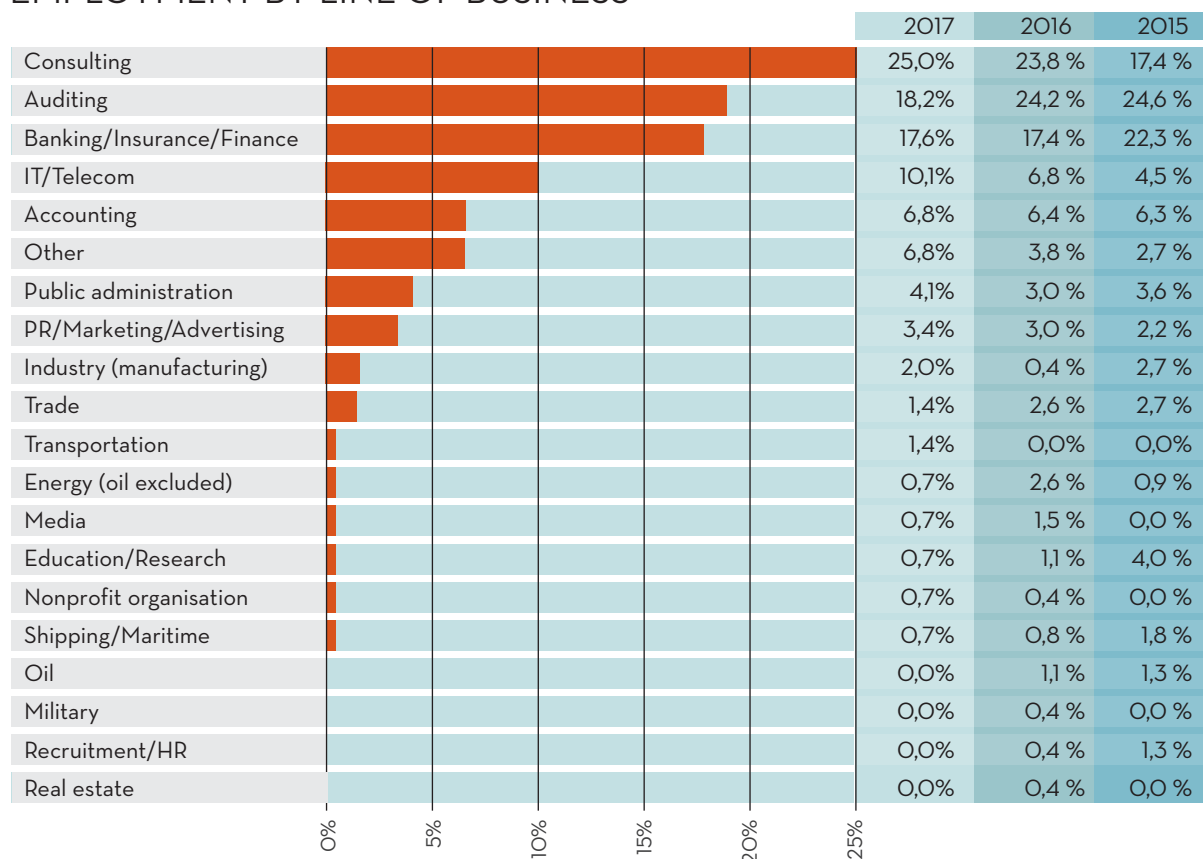


## ENTREPRENEURSHIP AMONG NHH-CANDIDATES

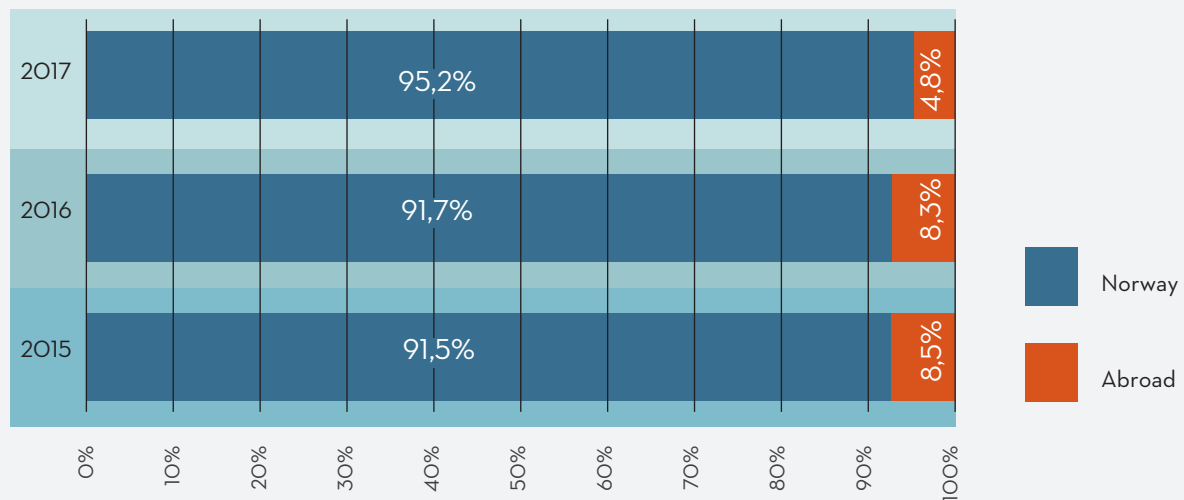


Share of candidates working full time in their own company/business

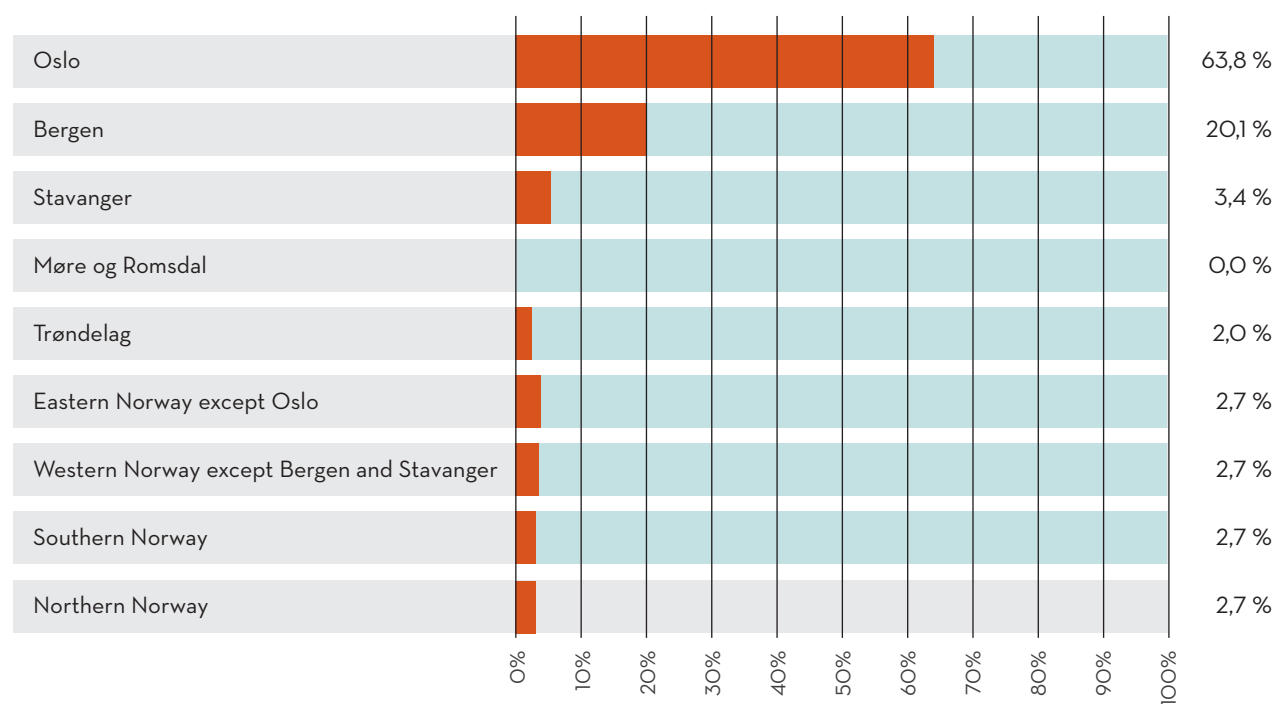
## EMPLOYMENT BY LINE OF BUSINESS
