He received his Ph.D. from University of California at Santa Barbara in 1979. His main research areas are game theory, intergenerational justice and green national accounting. Geir B. Asheim (joint with Martin Dufwenberg) received the Royal Economic Society Prize for the best paper published in the Economic Journal in 2003.
