WHAT IS IT

- √ Funding to promote investigator-driven, or 'bottom-up', frontier research
- √ A grant that emphasizes on high-quality innovative proposals, not prioritized areas.
- √ A programme with scientific excellence as the sole awarding criterion

WHO CAN APPLY

- √ Researchers of any nationality with 7-12 years of experience since completion of their PhD
- √ Researchers with a scientific track record showing great promise
- ✓ Single researchers, in conjunction with and on behalf of their host institution

WHAT IS FUNDED

- Research costs, including personnel costs, travelling expenses, data acquisition, open access expenses, and organisation of workshops, etc.
- √ Total maximum funding: 2 000 000 €
- √ Project period: 5 years

to keep in mind

The evaluation criteria are the researcher's and project's quality:

- √ Pioneering and ground breaking project.
- ✓ Provide evidence of leadership & creative thinking.
- √ Projects must address important challenges.
- √ 2-Step evaluation process, with interview & quarantines.

suggested timeline

- June: Identify the core project idea
- 2 September: Prepare an initial draft
- 3 November: Feedback from trusted peers
- 4 March: Deadline to submit the proposal
