WHAT IS IT

- ✓ Applications can be targeted to some **specific research areas** (*Oceans or Climate and polar research*), or to the bottom-up **ground-breaking research** programme (applications must be bold and innovative).
- ✓ A grant to encourage scientific quality at the forefront of international research.
- ✓ A programme to promote bold and innovative scientific thinking and scientific innovation.

WHO CAN APPLY

- ✓ Researchers with 2-7 years experience after their PhD at closing of the deadline
- ✓ Researchers should be under 40 years of age at the closing of the deadline
- ✓ Organisations such as companies and other undertakings, may not be project partners in Researcher projects.

WHAT IS FUNDED

- ✓ Projects carried out by an young promising researcher who can employ researchers as team members
- ✓ Total maximum funding: 8 000 000 NOK
- ✓ Project period: 3-4 years

to keep in mind

Proposals are judged on their research quality and the quality of the principal investigator:

- ✓ The principal investigator should demonstrate independence from the PhD supervisor.
- ✓ The principal investigator is expected to apply for European funding.
- ✓ Any given researcher can only apply as PI in one application (contact FAA if considering more than one).

timeline

- 1 June: Identify the core project idea
- 2 September: Prepare an initial draft
- 3 November: Feedback from trusted peers
- 4 **February: Deadline to submit the proposal**
