WHAT IS IT

- ✓ Funding for top-down projects to address major EU concerns
- ✓ Funding to tackle the concern from multiple angles. It will help bridge resources and knowledge across different fields, technologies and disciplines, including social sciences and the humanities

WHAT IS FUNDED & WHO CAN APPLY

- ✓ Consortia of academic and non-academic organizations
- ✓ Total funding: call specific (~ 3-5M €). Each partner can receive different amounts
- ✓ Project period: 4 years

PRIORITIZED CHALLENGES

-  Health, demographic change and well-being
-  Food security, sustainable agriculture and forestry, marine and maritime and inland water research, and the bioeconomy
-  Secure, clean and efficient energy
-  Smart, green and integrated transport
-  Climate action, environment, resource efficiency and raw materials
-  Europe in a changing world - inclusive, innovative and reflective societies
-  Secure societies - protecting freedom and security of Europe and its citizens

to keep in mind

- ✓ Proposals are judged on their ability to address the specific challenge proposed in the call from multiple angles.
- ✓ Each partner typically focuses on one aspect of the project.
- ✓ The evaluation is a 2-step process with quarantines.

timeline

Exact deadline depending of the call

- 1 Month 0: Identify the core project idea
- 2 Month 3: Map interest of potential partners
- 3 Month 4: Workshop, project draft and road-map
- 4 Month 7: Final consortium, stakeholders and work plan
- 5 Month 8-14: Proposal preparation
